Congratulations to the Maleny Swimming Club's 5 swimmers who were eligible to attend the Wide Bay Super Camp on July 9th and 10th 2011.

There are two eligibility categories for this event:

Early Achiever's Squad – Swimmers are selected who have achieved Green or Bronze status on the JX (Junior Excellence) program and who have competed at Wide Bay Championships in March and swum a 200IM. They have also swum at 5 meets in the Wide Bay region. They are also aged 11 -13 years as at 31st March 2011. Alana and Ben Eggins, Caelen Dwyer and Jacob Diefenbach qualified as Early Achievers.

And;

Achiever's Squad – Swimmers are selected who have achieved Silver or Gold status on the JX program and who have competed at Wide Bay Championships in March and swum a 200IM. They are also aged 11 -13 years as at 31st March 2010. The swimmers have competed at 5 meets in the Wide Bay region over the season. Elsa Jonsson qualified in the Achievers Squad.

Alana, Ben and Elsa attended this camp which included competing at the Sunshine Coast Qualifying Meet at Matthew Flinders on Sunday July the 10th. Carl Jonsson also competed there.

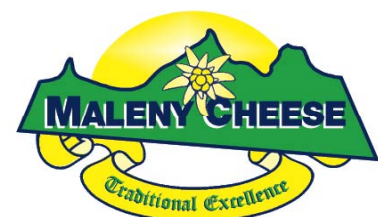

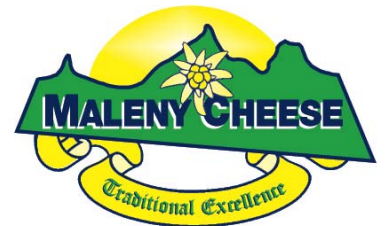
