A working bee was held on Sunday the 15th of August to spring clean and spruce up the pool complex. Thank you to those who gave up their time.

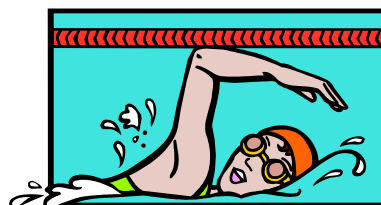


Club Sign on

For example, a family with two parents and two swimmers would need to complete one Maleny Swimming Club form and four SQ forms. The third form shows the fees and the membership types that you need to fill in.

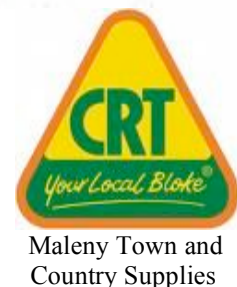
