The new covers, costing \$2400 were purchased due to a generous grant provided by the Sunshine Coast Regional Council.

Redbacks' curator Scott Corkin is impressed with the new covers, measuring 30 metres by 16 metres, and stated "these covers will guarantee that prepared wickets are safe

and games can be played as often as possible, even during wet weeks.

They are specially designed for turf pitches and can be left on for extended times without causing the grass to die off. This is important with our curating being performed on a voluntary basis and around work commitments."
