Maleny Redbacks U15 v's Glasshouse

The Redbacks travelled away to Glasshouse for a two day game.

Glasshouse won the toss and elected to bat and was dismissed for 87 in the 30th over.

Bowling for the Redbacks saw Nick Selman take 3 for 8, Josh Bradbury 2 for 1, Blaize Underwood 1 for 7, Harrison Canton 1 for 8 and Moacyr Lima and Dylan Davies both take 1 for 10.

Isaac Bradbury, Daniel Hand and Adam Brown all took great catches in the field.

The Redbacks batted and at the end of the first day were 7 for 107. Continuing their innings on the following morning the Redbacks were dismissed for 122. Batting for the Redbacks saw Harrison Canton make 23, Brae Furlong 23, Dylan Davies 22, Daniel Hand 16 and Ben Edwards 15.

Glasshouse batted again and declared at 7 for 122 from 37 overs.

Bowling for Maleny saw Nick Selman pick up his second five wicket haul for the season 5 for 11, Isaac Bradbury 1 for 16 and Ben Wilkinson 1 for 16.

Though there were four good catches taken in the field by Harrison Canton, Blaize Underwood, Adam Brown and Ben Wilkinson, there was three relatively easy catches put down which allowed two batsmen to put on a stand of 91 runs, when they both should have been back in the pavilion much earlier being spectators and not out in the centre re-shaping the game.

The declaration left the Redbacks 87 runs to get for an outright and they finished 2 for 53 just coming up short due to accurate bowling by Glasshouse.
