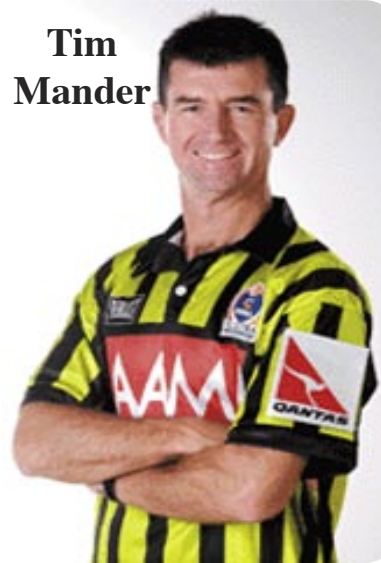
Once again, your chef will be Sherry Wright, with MC Simon Denver and John Mays will serenade you in his unique style.
