Shakespeare Gets a Shake Up!

With "Statespeare", creator and director Nelle Lee and the band of four young and energetic actors want to challenge the notion that Shakespeare is suited only to drama nerds and performance addicts.

The scene is set when a group of Year 12 students are given an

assignment requiring them to prove, or disprove, the claim that Shakespeare's plays can still be relevant today.

Taking the texts of various plays, the students work through a variety of scenes and, in acting them out, discover that the language itself has a certain timeless magic with the plays having great universal and abiding themes, as relevant today as when Shakespeare was at his peak.

The production has toured widely to great acclaim from students, teachers and adults alike.

Maleny Rotary is a member of MDSARC Inc.

The Maleny Rotary Club has been part of the Maleny community since 1959. It is an affiliated member of the MDSARC Inc.

Perhaps the most significant project undertaken by the Rotary Club of Maleny was the development of Mary Cairncross Scenic Reserve which involved the input of thousands of hours over many years of both Rotarians and their partners.

This reserve has been a community asset since being donated to the community by the Thynne Family.

The Reserve is home to the *Phyllodes imperialis* (southern subspecies), an impressive moth with a 14 cm wingspan.

The only location identified as a breeding ground for the moth is Mary Cairncross Reserve. Many other notable species of flora and fauna can be found in the reserve and club is an integral part of the community's effort to preserve the area for future generations.

The reserve is earmarked for further upgrade to its facilities and the Rotary Club of Maleny has recently reaffirmed its ongoing financial and physical support for this wonderful community asset.

The Elizabeth (Bessie), Mary and Mabel Thynne must be remembered for their visionary gift.

The Back of Beyond in Maleny!

The acclaimed award winning Movie *The Back Of Beyond* won the Best Film award at the Venice film festival - in 1954.

The movie tells the story of legendary outback mailman, Tom Kruse, who delivered mail to properties along the Birdsville Track.

The photo below shows the movie version of Kruse emerging over the sand hills in his reliable Leyland Badger, comes Her Majesty's Royal Mailman Tom Kruse, with his passenger William Henry, his assistant travelled in the back, ploughing through the desert to bring the mail to the people living on stations and outposts along the track - 'their only link to the outside world'.



The Lions Club of Maleny and Blackall Range are pleased to be presenting the "Outback Movie Night" on Saturday 12th November at Maleny Baptist Church starting at 7pm.

Also included in the evening will be the documentary made by the ABC in 1999 *Last Mail from Birdsville*. More than 750,000 people saw this movie in the 2 years after its release; it was then distributed world wide and an estimated 25 million people have seen it. When Queen Elizabeth saw the movie in 1954, she was so impressed she awarded Tom Kruse (the mailman) an MBE!

Interestingly, Lions member and Maleny resident, Ralph Ding is the nephew of the original owner of the Birdsville Mail (for whom Tom Kruse was the mailman driver). Tom and his assistant, aboriginal assistant, Henry Butler worked for Harry Ding and the first trip was made in 1930 and continued until 1960. Tom Kruse died only recently in June 2011.

All funds raised on the day are to be donated to the Maleny Hospital.


The tournaments are growing in popularity and received considerable media coverage including Local 7, the Sunshine Coast Daily & the Range News.
