Does your club need extra funding?

Two further rounds of funding opens today for not-for-profit community organisations, sport and recreation clubs, schools and councils.

These organisations can now apply for funding for healthy eating projects under the Active Inclusion program, and an extra round of Sports Infrastructure funding.

“For this round of Active Inclusion, \$4.2 million is available for a special ‘Healthy Eating and Physical Activity Category’ as well as the other sport and recreation categories from

the first round.” said Sport Minister Phil Reeves.

Funds of up to \$5,000 will be available for Club Support Projects that build clubs through education and training, recruiting and retaining volunteers and encouraging participation in sport and recreation in their community.”

Interested groups can apply for up to \$50,000 by submitting an application between 1 September and 15 October 2010.

Loss of Maleny Scout Group

Unfortunately the Maleny Scout Group has had to close its doors because we have been unable to attract adults into the role of leaders for Cub and Scouts.

The group had been going prior to WW1 with interruptions during WW1 and WW2. The group was registered on 27 May 1927.

The group lost their scout hall (the old RSL Hall that they paid 50 pounds for) in Bicentenary Lane in 2003 when the Maleny Community Centre reclaimed the hall and land that they hold in Trust for the Maleny community.

This had been the start of the death knoll for the group as we had been unable to find suitable premises to meet and store our gear on a permanent basis. In 2005 we used the Maleny Girl Guide Hut and in 2008 the Maleny Historical Society offered their site for the group to meet and have their storage container with all the groups camping gear.

We thank the Maleny Historical Society for all the support that they have given the group over the last couple of years.

The youth members have transferred to Landsborough Scout Group which meets at the Rocky Creek Campsite, 3246 Gympie Road South, Landsborough.
