### ***Kronk tames Brumbies***

A marvellous century by Redback Steve Kronk has led the Maleny Seniors cricket side to victory over the Burpengary Brumbies on Saturday.

Winning the toss and electing to field, Burpengary were soon rueing their decision with the temperature and Maleny's batting quickly heat-

ing up. Redbacks' openers Ryan Cosgrove and Rob Wilkes were in striking form racing the score to 68 runs off just 10 overs.

When Cosgrove was out for a hasty 46, Kronk entered the innings and took control of the game. Kronk smashed the ball to all parts of the ground crucifying some wayward bowling.

Wilkes (25 runs) departed in the 18th over bringing Scott Corkin to the crease. Kronk and Corkin built on the Redbacks' score with a blistering 121 run partnership.

While Kronk was brutal smashing 6 sixes, Corkin showed control pushing singles to allow his batting partner to strike. Kronk brought up his century with a classical pull shot for six.

The stifling heat finally got the better of the old boys with Kronk dismissed for 110 in the 34th over and Corkin (33 runs) out in the following over.

Youngsters Jake Heading (37 not out) and Nick Selman (20 not out) finished off the Redbacks' innings smashing 67 runs in the last five overs to amass a massive total of 293.

Maleny entered the field chas-

ing quick wickets and keen to get through as many overs as possible before the rain came.

Krishna Alister answered the call, claiming a wicket in the first over. Jake Heading and Greg Corkin entered the attack pushing through the overs to ensure a result.

Bowling what some might describe as spin, Heading kept the scoring to a minimum claiming 0 for 20 off 7 overs, while Corkin grabbed 2 for 12 off 5.

An eventful 2 over spell by Jason Brittle, claiming 3 wickets, plus run outs to Greg Corkin and Heading saw the Brumbies reeling at 8 for 91 in the 22nd over when the rain came.

With no more play possible the Redbacks claimed victory due to superior run rate.

### Maleny Redbacks slay Snakes



Nick Selman and Ben Edwards led an undermanned Maleny Redbacks, Under 17's cricket team to a stunning one day victory over the Caboolture Snakes.

Playing short due to the start of the school holidays, the Redbacks were disadvantaged from the outset.

However Nick Selman and Ben Edwards turned the game in Maleny's advantage with a fine batting display. Selman dominated the scoring, regularly depositing the Snakes' bowlers to the boundary, while Edwards supported his partner with many classical strokes. The pair combined to produce a 148 run opening partnership.

Edwards was finally out in the late overs for a well made 42. After securing an outstanding century, Selman was dismissed in the last over of the innings for an impressive 107. At the end of their allotted overs Maleny had scored 161

The Redbacks started their time in the field knowing that their lack of numbers would make scoring easy for the Snakes. Maleny's opening bowlers, Tim McMurray (0 for 19 off 6) and Moe Lima (0 for 22 off 6), limited the oppositions scoring opportunities with line and length bowling.

Caboolture were cruising at 0 for 83, before run outs to Robert Corrin and Lima, and an inspired spell of bowling by Edwards change the game. Edwards claimed 3 for 29 off 6 overs and remained strong to restrict the Snakes to 5 for 145 off their 30 overs.

This week's victory has secured Maleny's position in the top three as they enter the school holiday break.

The Sommer Fuel Supplies player of the match goes to Nick Selman for his outstanding century.
