## New DVD helps hearing impaired athletes

State Member for Glasshouse, Carolyn Male MP today launched a DVD aimed at increasing opportunities for hearing impaired Queenslanders to participate in sport and recreation.

Carolyn Male MP said the Australian Sign Language (Auslan) in Sport DVD is a vital communication tool for the sport and recreation industry.

“All Queenslanders should have the opportunity to participate in sport and recreation – no matter where they live, their age, or ability,” Carolyn Male MP said.

“That is why we cultivate partnerships across the sport and recreation industry with organisations like Deaf

Sports and Recreation Queensland.” “We are pleased to support Deaf Sports and Recreation Queensland in providing \$33,000 funding to develop this DVD.”

Users will be able to view and learn basic Auslan, which can then be applied during training and on the sporting field. Having these important basic skills can lead to overall increased participation in sport and recreation, and can lead to other flow on benefits for our local clubs.

“This is going to be an invaluable resource for all sport and recreation representatives and I encourage the sport and recreation industry to give it a go,” said Ms Male M.P.

### Maleny Redbacks 3rds lose in nail biter

The Maleny Redbacks 3rd Division Cricket team lost in a nail biting one day match against Caloundra on Saturday.

Fresh from their Christmas break and eager to start the new year off with a win, the Redbacks travelled to Caloundra to take on the Lighthouses in the last of the one day matches.

Losing the toss and being sent in on a rain affected turf wicket, Maleny lost regular wickets and struggled to build a suitable total.

At 8 for 59, the Redbacks were in dire straits, however Ajit Alister and Jason Brittle combined in a 50 run partnership to push the Redbacks' tally past 100. When Ajit Alister, scoring 39, was the last wicket to fall, Maleny had amassed a defendable 124.

With Caloundra having to score at 3 runs an over, the Redbacks knew they would have bowl good lines, take regular wickets and be sharp in the field. Maleny's fielding was highlighted by a superb one handed,

diving catch to Krishna Alister, showing that taking 'speckies' is an Alister family trait.

The Maleny bowlers used the conditioned well, bowling tight throughout the innings to have Caloundra 7 for 118 with 2 overs to go.

Unfortunately Caloundra was able to pass Maleny's total with a few balls to spare, providing them with victory.

Maleny 3rd's next game is a two day local derby against Kenilworth at Kenilworth.

Between the eight swimmers pictured they scooped a combined 27 medals in the month of November.

These results are the fruits of some dedicated training efforts and the club is justifiably proud of every one of them.

Caelen Dwyer was awarded two silver and a bronze at Bribie Island on 15 Nov for 50m Butterfly, 50m Backstroke and 50m Freestyle.

Dean Hale scooped 4 bronze at Bribie Island in the 50m Freestyle Final Dash for Cash, 50m Backstroke, 50m Breaststroke and in the 100m Individual Medley. Dean also gained silver in the Coolum Carnival on 1 Nov in the 50m

Breaststroke.

Jaden Eather shone with Gold at Bribie Island winning all three of his events which comprised the 50m Breaststroke, 50m Backstroke and 50m Freestyle.

Natalie Weyman, the club's current state level swimmer was awarded gold in the 50m Backstroke and silver in the 100m Backstroke at Jindalee on 16 November giving her outstanding qualifying times for the next state meet at Chandler in Brisbane in December.

Ella also took out a silver in the Gympie Goldrush carnival on 29 November and at Coolum in 50m Breaststroke.
