Round 1 opens 29 July 2010 and closes midnight 15 September 2010 for projects starting after 1 January 2011.

Round 2 opens 20 January 2011 and closes midnight 15 March 2011 for projects starting after 1 July 2011.

The grants can be applied for on line and are under the following classifications;

Sport and Recreation Projects that encourage the development of cost-effective programs, facilities and events that promote active community participation in sport and recreational pursuits.

Community Development Projects that make a positive contribution to the quality of

life in the Sunshine Coast region
