Maleny won the toss and decided to field to make the most of a bowler friendly Maleny pitch. Krishna Alister and Nathan Perry were the best of the Maleny bowlers, both picking up some vital wickets. However the Redbacks gave away too many free runs, bowling 22 wides as Kenilworth produced an excellent total of 8 for 241 off their 40 overs.

Dave Griffiths playing his first game for the season, impressed with an excellent outfield catch, although the method he used was a little unconventional.

Maleny started their innings at a quick pace with Dan Cork and Tim Cork scoring 25 and 26 respectively. At 2 for 53 the Redbacks were looking for a solid partnership to push the score along, however some outstanding bowling by Kenilworth's Jason Woods saw Maleny lose quicks wickets and in dire straits at 7 for 59. Woods eventually had the impressive bowling figures of 5 for 16 off 8 overs.

Maleny's tail wagged, with Jon O'Connell and Dan Hand supporting Todd English, batting for the first time this season, score 19 not out. Maleny was finally dismissed for 94.

The One Dayers continue next Saturday with the Redbacks looking to bounce back from last weekend's defeat.
