MDSRC welcomes Council's Precinct decision

The Maleny District Sport and Recreation Club applauds Council's decision to progress the Maleny Community precinct. We congratulate Cr Jenny McKay for her leadership role in securing outcomes which will serve the sporting, recreational and environmental needs of Maleny and other hinterland communities.

Over the past year, 28 clubs have banded together in a unique partnership under the MDSRC to identify and meet the sporting and recreational needs of our wider community. We proposed a mix of sporting facilities on the Precinct, including four ovals, an athletics track, an aquatic centre, two bowls greens, a community golf course, and a joint club house to service these facilities. The Club House would also meet the needs of other recreation groups such as the Bridge Club.

Not all our affiliated Clubs are seeking access to the Precinct. Some will continue to use the Show Grounds or the Witta Sports Grounds. One important objective of the MDSRC is to work with all affiliated Clubs so that we can address in a coordinated and integrated manner the serious shortfall in sporting and recreational facilities on the hinterland.

In shaping the recommendations, Council officers engaged the Strategic Leisure Group to review and assess the sports audit which had been conducted by MDSRC. Though given no opportunity to meet with the consultants and

present our case in greater detail, we were pleased to see that the consultants largely accepted our shortfall claims. They recognised the key role that the Maleny Precinct can play in overcoming these deficiencies. In particular, the consultants recommended the Precinct for soccer ovals, bowls greens and the long mooted aquatic centre.

To expedite the Master Planning process, Council will set aside \$250,000 to recruit a project manager who will oversee the whole planning exercise, including preparation of an overarching business plan for the Precinct. Council will outsource the preparation of the Master Plan. We look forward to working with Council and its consultants over the coming months to deliver to our community a range of first class facilities of which our community can be rightly proud.

These important developments will be discussed at MDSRC's AGM on Thursday 21 May, 5.30pm sharp at the Maleny Bowls Club; and at the Maleny Golf Club's AGM, the following week, same place, same time. Mike Norman www.md-sarcinc.com
