Patience and the Maleny Performing Arts Orchestra

There are always interesting tales behind the scenes for every large production and the upcoming Maleny Singer's production of Gilbert and Sullivan's *Patience* is no exception. Did you know that right here in Maleny we now have our own orchestra? Here is their story.

Formed three years ago, when a dear friend of Margaret Taylor's, Chas Bromley attended the Singer's production of *The Gondoliers*, and enquired "Why don't you have an orchestra?" "We can't afford one!" she replied.

Spurred into action, Chas phoned his musical friends and colleagues and as a result, formed a super little pit orchestra appropriately named... what else... *the Maleny Performing Arts Orchestra*.

Margaret's friendship with Chas and his wife Jenny began when Margaret and her late husband moved to Queensland in 2003.

Derek and Chas had been colleagues in the British Army many years ago; Chas is a very fine flautist, and after leaving the army, moved to Australia and played as principal flute with the famous Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra for many years.

On moving to the Sunshine Coast, Chas became conductor of the Sunshine Coast Orchestra until ill health forced him to retire some years ago. Happily for Maleny music lovers, he is still playing flute for the Singers' productions.

Amongst the other MPAO players are Maree (first violin) and Trevor (bassoon) Williamson, dedicated enough to drive from Brisbane for every rehearsal and performance.

When Derek was conductor of the St Lucia Orchestra in Brisbane, Maree was his leader and Trevor - late of the Australian Navy Band, was the lead bassoon.

Many of the other players play with the Sunshine Coast Orchestra. They are fortunate to have Anne Bowyer as lead cellist once again, and this year she has a very interesting part to play in the production!

Several members of the group are local musicians, namely Allyson Williams on violin (and also married to one of the cast), and Janet Rowley - flute.

Their leader this year is Chrissy Davis.

The conductor of MPAO is the extremely talented Margaret Taylor

- a job which she took up very nervously three years ago, but which she clearly enjoys more with each new Singer's production.

Her love of *Patience* began as a member of the D'Oyly Carte Opera Company; she later played the title role in the West End production with the English National Opera, you could say she is very familiar with the piece!

The Singers and Maleny Performing Arts Orchestra look forward to performing for Maleny audiences in June; tickets are already selling fast so don't miss out and make your booking now - tickets on sale at The Bower Bird, Maleny.

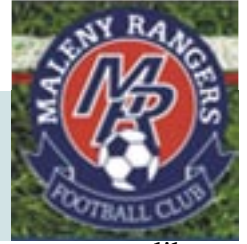
