Maleny Interact Club is "Best in S.E. Queensland!"

Congratulations to students and staff at Maleny High and Rotarians Dick Andrew and Deb Lynde - at the annual District Interact Convention last Saturday, the Maleny Rotary Interact Club was judged to be the best club in SE Queensland. As a result they were awarded the Philip Blakey Shield.

Interact is a Rotary-sponsored service club for young people age 14-18. Interact Clubs can either be school or community based and are required to carry out at least two service projects annually.

Of the two projects one must benefit the school or community and one that furthers international understanding.

The Maleny Interact Club raised over \$3,600 by running a sausage

sizzle at Bunnings for the "Shave for a Cure" day, raising much needed funds for the Leukaemia Foundation.

An Interact club must have a minimum of 15 members and the club is required to meet at least twice a month. To remain eligible for membership, Interactors must attend 60 percent or more of the regular meetings.

The first Interact club was formed at Melbourne High School in Florida, USA on 28 October 1962. The club had 23 members. Today, there are 6,605 Interact clubs in 101 countries and an estimated 151,915 Interactors worldwide.

This is the 2nd year in a row that the Maleny Interact Club has been the winner!
